Dear Mr. Schroeder,

This is a final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for a copy of any records, reports, transcripts, minutes, appendices, working papers, drafts, studies, other documents or photographs of the "22 surface-to-air-missiles" seized by Task Force Baghdad on January 2006. Our command made a careful search and found one responsive document (enclosed).

After a thorough review of the document, I determined that certain information is exempt from release. Portions of the information are currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order 12958 as amended by 13292, Section 1.4 (a) as information pertaining to military plans, weapons systems, or operations. Therefore, all "blacked out" information is withheld pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b) (1), and DOD 5400.7-R, paragraph C3.2.1.1.


Accordingly, in my capacity as the Initial Denial Authority, by withholding the redacted portions of the information, I am partially denying your request. All fees are waived for this request. You may appeal this decision within 60 calendar days of the date above to the Office of the Freedom of Information, Suite 12047, 1155 Defense Pentagon, Washington, DC 20301-1155.

Additionally, while processing this FOIA request, our subordinate unit determined that 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade 1<sup>st</sup> Armor Division (3/1 AR), may have responsive documents.
