ALPHABETICAL KEY WORDS/TERMS INDEX FOR EXECUTIVE ORDER 12656

Notes:

1. All listings refer to sections and/or subsections of Executive Order (EO) 12656 only.
 2. The listed terms from EO 12656 have various, undefined sources. Most have an historical origin or significance in that they derive from or repeat terms that were first used during the 1950s - 1960s in numerous administrative and Executive orders. In some cases, they have an unspecified statutory significance or basis. In other cases, they are "terms of art" that have a special meaning to only one or more departments and agencies. Although only one term ("national security emergency") is defined in EO 12656, most of the listed terms have significance, in one way or another, for operational planning purposes.
 3. In those cases where a key term, such as "national security emergency" appears frequently or in most sections, no comprehensive listing of section references is given. Instead, the term "all" is used. See, e.g., "function(s)".
 4. No commas are used to separate references to subsections within section citations. "301(3)(6)" means subsections 3 and 6 of section 301. "301(3)-(6)" means subsections 3, 4, 5 and 6 of section 301. "301(3)(a)(4)" means subsections (3)(a) and (4) of section 301.
 5. Bold-font section references "**301**" in department/agency listings indicate "lead" and "support" mission assignments. Any other section references under a department/agency listing are to those sections in which that department/agency is mentioned in some way.
 6. Key terms/words preceded by an asterisk (*) indicate a "resource" related term. This index takes a broad approach to "resource" categories. For example, it includes "enemy aliens," in that they can be considered as possible intelligence assets to be exploited in a national security emergency. Planning for such an emergency needs to consider this "resource." A similar approach is used for other, less obvious terms. Therefore, this designation may appear remote, subjective, or unclear, and is dependent on the perspective of the analyst or reader. In any case, this "resource" designation is not meant to be definitive, but only a starting point for discussion and further analysis.
 7. EO 12656 has four "whereas" clauses. Listed terms used in such clauses are included in this listing, and appear ahead of a section reference shown as "whereas;" given immediately after the indexed term.
