- NASA has updated and completed five (5) internal classification guides (All guides have now been updated).
- NASA has approved one (1) new internal classification guide.
- NASA assisted in the updating and approval of three (3) DOE/DOD/NASA joint classification guides.
- NASA consolidated one (1) program. No projects, programs, or categories were eliminated, revised or condensed.
- NASA did not downgrade the classification level any documents, topics or categories.
- NASA did not have any cases in which the duration of classification was modified or exemptions from declassification were removed.
- The NASA Declassification Guide was submitted to ISOO on January 2012. NASA is awaiting official approval from ISCAP.
- NASA Procedural Requirements (NPR) 1600.2, NASA Classified National Security Information guidance was approved on October 18, 2011.
