SUBJECT: Security Reminder

All DHS personnel are reminded that just because classified information appears in the public domain it does not mean that the information has been declassified by proper authority. Executive Order 13526, "Classified National Security Information," Section 1.1.(c) states, "Classified Information shall not be declassified automatically as a result of any unauthorized disclosure of identical or similar information."

Therefore, in accordance with this order and current Departmental policy, personnel should not use any unclassified system to access, download or attempt to download from a public web site any information that is believed to be classified, nor should they comment or confirm the degree of sensitivity of such information, or discuss the content in a potentially classified document with persons who would not otherwise be authorized access.
